The Needs of Oregon's Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs

The Federal Title V Maternal and Child Health Services Block Grant awards funds to each state to serve women, children and youth, including children and youth with special health care needs (CYSHCN). The block grant requires that each state conduct a statewide needs assessment every five years to identify state priorities and inform strategic planning. OCCYSHN partners with the Oregon Health Authority Maternal and Child Health section to implement Oregon's Title V block grant by addressing the CYSHCN population. This talk will overview the block grant program and share findings from OCCYSHN's portion of the statewide needs assessment.

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
