

Please note the following changes in SPH Prefix and Course Numbers (May 2018)

New Prefix: EPI

Epidemiology courses that use the PHPM (Public Health & Preventive Medicine) prefix change to the new “EPI” prefix. This will more clearly identify them as epidemiology courses. The course numbers are all be kept as is.

EPI 512/612 – Epidemiology I

Within the new EPI prefix, the current PHPM 512/612 – Epidemiology I course will now be listed as the sole Epi I offering (EPI 512/612); PHE 530 or CPH 541/641 will no longer be listed.

BSTA 525 – Intro to Biostatistics

This course replaces PHE 515 and PHPM 524, neither of which will be listed. This is a new course number because Intro to Biostats is taken by HP, HMP and PHCHD students, and is slightly different that BSTA 511 – Estimation & Hypothesis Testing/Applied Biostats, which is the required course for students in the Epi, Biostats & ESHH programs. The different course requirement are already/have always been reflected in the degree requirements for the various MPH programs.

ESHH 511/611 – *Concepts of Environmental Health* will be the sole Concepts of Environmental Health course; CPH 539, PHE 580 and PHPM 518 will no longer be listed.

HSMP 574/674 – *Health System Organization* will be the sole Health System Organization course; CPH 540/640 will no longer be listed.

PHE 512 - *Principles of Health Behavior* will be the sole Principles of Health Behavior course; CPH 537/637 will no longer be listed. Note: PHE 612 is a separate course - Advanced Principles of Health Behavior, and will continue to be offered as such.

Consolidation of Core Course Listings

- *Epidemiology I*: EPI 512/612 replaces CPH 541/641, PHE 530, and PHPM 512/612.
- *Intro to Biostatistics*: BSTA 525 replaces PHE 515 and PHPM 524.
- *Concepts of Environmental Health*: ESHH 511/611 replaces CPH 539, PHE 580 and PHPM 518.
- *Health System Organization*: HSMP 574/674 replaces CPH 540/640.
- *Principles of Health Behavior*: PHE 512 replaces CPH 537/637.
