

Position Title: Program Evaluation Intern

Program Information: Illuminate is Portland State University's relationship and sexual violence prevention program. Illuminate uses the power of prevention education to promote healthy relationships and sexuality by addressing the underlying social determinants of violence and to create equal and respectful relationships.

Purpose: The Program Evaluation Intern will support Illuminate by evaluating program data collected from Spring 2018 - Spring 2019. Illuminate seeks to promote social justice and prevent sexual and intimate partner violence by creating positive social change through prevention programming such as bystander intervention, anti-oppression, and consent workshops.

Location: Portland State University, Center for Student Health and Counseling, in the Illuminate program, part of the Health Promotion Department.

Key Responsibilities may include:

- Gather and run data analyses from various sources in predefined database
- Develop or revise tools for Illuminate data collection
- Prepare an end report recommending ways to increase efficiency and effectiveness of Illuminate activities

Reports to: Relationship and Sexual Violence Prevention Coordinator

Time Commitment: To be arranged with program coordinator. Varies based on the requirements of the intern's graduate program.

Minimum Requirements:

Enrollment in a Masters of Public Health or Masters of Public Administration Program.

Basic knowledge of program monitoring, evaluation, and quantitative and qualitative analysis.

The work of the program includes discussions regarding topics such as sex, sexual violence, dating violence, anti-oppression, victim blaming and bystander intervention. The intern should be comfortable with these discussions.
