



PhD Program in Epidemiology Request for Comprehensive Examination INSTRUCTIONS

The comprehensive examination allows students to demonstrate the competencies listed for each of the Epidemiology PhD core courses, as well as the integration of knowledge and skills across courses required to facilitate the design and interpretation of epidemiologic studies. Successful completion of the exam is required for students to progress to the dissertation proposal stage of the program.

Requirements

Doctoral students must have completed all core courses with a grade of B or higher, or a "Pass" in Pass/Fail courses, to be eligible to take the comprehensive examination. Students must also be in good academic standing and have no outstanding incompletes.

Scheduling

The comprehensive examination is offered every year at the end of the summer term. Full-time students typically complete the examination after their first or second year of study. All students are required to take the exam no later than the end of their third year (12th term) in the program.

Format of Exam

The comprehensive examination has both written and oral components. Please refer to the PhD in Epidemiology Program Handbook for a full description of the Exam content, procedures, expectation, grading and outcomes.

Instructions

The student should submit the *Request for Comprehensive Examination* form to the Program Office (GH 233, sphregistration@ohsu.edu) at least 30 days prior to the exam.
