The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Scholars Program enhances HRSA's ability to recruit, hire, develop, and retain high-quality individuals as the next generation of public health leaders.



HRSA Scholars are provided a unique perspective across the organization and see how HRSA works towards accomplishing its mission of improving health outcomes and providing high-quality health care for those in need. The cornerstone of the Scholars Program is a structured, individualized, 12-month development program with a focus on specific public health programs.

Throughout the year Scholars will:

- **Participate in rotations across HRSA's Bureaus or Offices.**
- **Support activities and assignments** with a public health focus.
- **Connect with leaders across HRSA**, including HRSA Scholar alumni.
- **Work together to develop as a cohort**, including through development and training opportunities and small group sessions as well as individual development with a mentor.
