

PhD Student Continuous Enrollment OHSU - Recording	noted that APCC reviewed this item in December; it is regarding changing the tuition charges for dissertation students who are taking more than 20 dissertation credits at OHSU; currently tuition charges for OHSU students with 27 or more dissertation credits are higher than at PSU.	will bring this topic to the meeting to re-discuss the enrollment policy and the

Policy Review	 APCC viewed the recording on the policy proposal process created by . anoted it would be helpful to see an example of what a complete policy package looks like anoted wanting to integrate this across student work as well; wanting to come up with a way where the students can get credited for their feedback on items such as curriculum revisioning and course growth. are going to follow the OHSU policy or do we even need to create one if we are following it? proposed the idea of using an addendum instead of rewriting an entire policy. anoted there may be a misuse of language; believes we should be using the equity lens not equity tool (which is still being developed). 	will create pre- recorded message on equity lens and present at APCC June meeting APCC Members will review the SPH Admissions Committees 01-20-001 and SPH Research Integrity 01- 30-005 and provide written feedback at the June meeting.



It will not prepare this group to use the tool; will need to have extra time set aside to walk through the tool while reviewing the policy. noted that the below policies are active, but that they have not been formally approved. SPH Admissions Committees 01-20-001 suggested sending out the revised policies out for peer review, centered on equity implications. mentioned that there is a revision needed re: the PD's as they do not have access to compass training and can only ask faculty/staff to do it, but cannot check SPH Research Integrity 01-30-005 noted that the links on the policies could be broken; may want to add the actual policy numbers just in case noted that it's a link to a sponsored project; it isn't a single policy, but we could write out the page name for readers to locate provided the specific related policies below: **Research Involving Humans** Policy No. 04-05-005 **Research Misconduct** Policy No. 04-15-005 Chapter 4 of OHSU's policy manual has Research related policies.
