Fellowship Overview

The Community Health System Administrative Fellowship is a 12-month rotation- and projectbased program. Fellows will have the opportunity to meet with executives from across the system during dedicated one-on-one meetings, shadow leaders in their respective departments, attend executive leadership meetings, and take on system-wide projects. Fellows will be assigned an executive leader as their preceptor who is excited to provide support and leadership training.

Fellows will be exposed to all three Community Health System entities – Community Health Partners, Community Care Health, and Community Medical Centers – to develop skills and relationships which are valued across the organization. These entities represent Community Health System' medical staff foundation, insurance plan, and facilities respectively.
