<p>Review professional workforce development activities</p>	<p>First webinar on Oregon’s Public Health System was December 7, 2022. 89 registrants, 78 attendees. Recording here.</p> <p>Second webinar on Public Health Policy in Oregon was February 23, 2023. 126 registrants, 74 attendees. Recording here.</p> <p>Third webinar scheduled for April 25, 2023 on Funding Oregon’s Public Health System and PH modernization. Registration link now live.</p> <p>Working with [all names redacted]to market opportunities and [all names redacted] on updating/revamping SPH website to highlight these offerings.</p> <p>CLHO is interested in continuing to partner on future series in the fall.</p> <p>Discussed ways to engage SPH students in webinars as networking opportunity. 21% of first webinar was students. Group generally pleased with this number.</p> <p>PH Preceptor ECHO just completed cohort 1! Had about 25 people who regularly attended. Two known outcomes: Oregon Public Health Institute applying for grant to be a hub for student internship stipends and opening OHSU student housing to MPH students. 303030 Project	OHSU SPH got an award through the state's 303030 initiative to expand training. Will be implementing two programs annually to: 1) increase the pipeline of PSU students from diverse backgrounds who enroll in the OHSU MPH program (n=10) or SON BSN program (n=5) and 2) increase the number of rural residents who enroll in the OHSU SPH's online MPH program (n=10). Details are being developed - but both programs offer full or partial tuition scholarships to selected students.
