





MSW and MPH - Health Management and Policy Track Dual Degree Curriculum

MSW Portland Campus Option and the School of Community Health

Students in the MSW/MPH Health Management and Policy track will need to complete at least 122 credits, which consists of 69 Social Work credits and 53 Public Health credits. (See sample course map below.)

In this sample course of study, Public Health coursework will count for 9 credits of MSW requirements as follows: BSTA 525 Introduction to Biostatistics (4 credits) will count as SW 551 (3 credits) in the MSW foundation research sequence, HSMP Organizational Behavior in Health Service Organizations (3 credits) and HSMP Program Evaluation and Management in Health Services (3 credits) will count as six SW elective credits. The 9-credit MSW three-course advanced practice concentration sequence will count toward MPH elective credits.

There are 19 shared credits. Note that MPH course scheduling may vary; this course of study model and courses may be re-sequenced. Please check with each department to determine the year's schedule.
