HOSPITALS

Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU)

As the state of Oregon's only public health and research university, OHSU is a unique resource for Oregonians and the place where healing, teaching and discovery come together. Volunteers are placed in a variety of settings in both patient care and non-patient care depending on their skills, interests, and previous experience.

MEDICAL SCRIBE PROGRAMS (PAID POSITIONS)

Scribing is a paid job and a serious commitment. Scribes shadow the Emergency Room and specialty clinic physicians, following them into every patient room, recording the patient's history and reason for visiting, and transcribing the physical exam as the doctor dictates. Scribes also organize pending lab and x-ray results. Students who have scribed say the experience helped them dramatically with their preparation for medical school and understanding of medicine.
